#### Make an Emergency Kit for Work

Whether it is just a sudden snowstorm that makes driving difficult or a more serious event, like an earthquake or flood - be aware that disasters can strike anytime – and you may need to stay at your workplace for a while. Put together a small emergency kit and keep it at your desk or in your locker.

#### Possible items for your work emergency kit include:

- Flashlight, with extra batteries (or choose a crank-powered flashlight)
- Food supplies (like power bars) in a sealed, vermin-proof container
- Medications (Check with your pharmacist about proper storage and rotation)
- Personal hygiene supplies toothbrush & toothpaste, mouthwash, soap, etc.
- An emergency charger pack for your cell phone
- Fresh underwear and a t-shirt that you can sleep in
- Cash & coins for vending machines if you have them at your location

#### Tips

- Coordinate your effort with others in your workplace items that can be used by the group include a portable radio and first aid supplies.
- If you have space, include a change of clothes and sturdy shoes & warm socks and a towel, and a small fleece blanket & inflatable pillow. You might also include some kind of entertainment – a favorite book, a puzzle, or a deck of cards.
- Consider creating a kit for each of your cars, too. Add booster cables and flares, plus a folding shovel & kitty litter or sand for traction if you get stuck in snow.
- Have your kids help you assemble these kits they will feel better if you are ever stuck at work or on the road, knowing how prepared you are.

#### **Emergency Blanket – the Bivvy Sack**

If you're forced to spend the unexpected night outdoors, an Emergency Bivvy might offer extra protection when the temperature drops. More than a simple emergency blanket, this is the kind of ultra-light, ultra-warm full protection shelter that professionals rely on. You might consider buying a Bivvy Sack for each family member. Try the SOL emergency bivvy offered by Forge Survival Supplies or Amazon's offer of the "Advanced Medical Kits Emergency Bivvy" - both under \$15.
